Highlander International Recycling was formed in 2002, to fulfil the need of recycling companies in identifying, exploring & ultimately serving new markets both at home and overseas for a wide range of high quality recovered paper grades.

Highlander moved to our new office and purpose built handling facility in 2011. The facility has recently been expanded giving us circa 24,000 square feet of fully enclosed and secure storage space and we have invested in modern handling equipment to allow us to unload, store and handle up to 7,000 tons of recovered paper in reel, sheet, loose and baled form.

The company has recently invested in a fully automatic reel splitting machine, capable of safely and efficiently splitting reels of paper of up to diameter 2.1 metres and reel length of 2.7 metres. The machine comes with a fully automated feed and discharge system and is capable of cutting the reel in several different positions to reduce the size of the pieces of paper left after the initial cut. The cutting force of the splitter is 400kn / 40 tons and the blade is stainless steel.

Highlander are now in a position to offer a competitive reel cutting service to a wide range of industries for redundant or damaged reels, such as Printers, (PTO)

of reel, which may suit customers who operate their own transport facilities and can drop off materials at their convenience. Highlander also offer a premium service, which is a security destruction process for sensitive reels that may be printed with confidential detailing or be watermarked with specific logos or motifs. This service includes the splitting, shredding, pulping and final recycling, with a destruction certificate issued as standard for each batch received.
